Free School Meals

Did you know the government gives additional funding to schools for those children entitled to free school meals (FSM)?

All infant children are entitled to a Universal Free School meal but Free School Meals (FSM) are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, certain benefits

Schools use this money to obtain additional staff and resources that help improve the quality of education for your child. There are other benefits for you as your child gets older such as uniform grants, funded club places and trips. Please use the FSM checker below to see if your child is eligible
